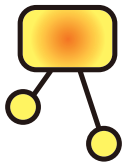


## Choose a Projector

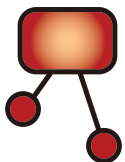
- Somewhere between 900 & 2000 ANSI lumens  
You'll need a completely dark room with a 900 ANSI projector, while a 2000 ANSI projector can cope with a light or two on.
- 16:9 native aspect ratio recommended



## Choose a Screen

- Choose a screen size that is in the mid-range of your projector's zoom. The biggest possible size will give the worst possible image.
- Comfortable viewing distance is somewhere around 2.5 – 3.5 the screen's width back.

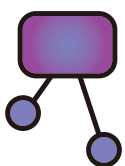

## Choose a Projector Mount

- First step is to work out where you will mount the projector

- Or see projector manufacturers specs for throw distance / calculator.
